Practice Privacy Notice Other Third Parties (Solicitors, employers, insurance companies etc.)

This privacy notice covers information provided to third party organisations such as solicitors (e.g. personal injury claims), insurance companies and employers etc.

The explicit consent of patients must be obtained and be demonstrable before the release of any such information.

3) Purpose of the processing	To enable healthcare professionals working in Chastleton medical Group to provide information to other third parties such as solicitors, insurance companies etc.
4) Lawful basis for processing	The processing of personal data for other third parties is supported under the following Article 6 and 9 conditions of the GDPR: <i>Article 6(1)(a) “the data subject has given consent to the processing of his or her personal data for one or more specific purposes.”</i> And <i>Article 9(2)(a) ‘the data subject has given explicit consent to the processing of those personal data for one or more specified purposes, except where Union or Member State law provide that the prohibition referred to in paragraph 1 may not be lifted by the data subject’</i>
5) Recipient or categories of recipients of the processed data	The requesting organisation
6) Rights to object	You have the right to object to some or all the information being processed under Article 21. Please contact the Data Controller or the practice. You should be aware that this is a right to raise an objection that is not the same as having an absolute right to have your wishes granted in every circumstance.
7) Right to access and correct	You have the right to access the data that is being shared and have any inaccuracies corrected. There is no right to have accurate medical records deleted except when ordered by a court of Law.
8) Retention period	The data will be retained in line with the third party organisations policies on storing identifiable data.

9) Right to Complain.
